CEMETERY MINUTES

May 19, 2016

The Brighton Cemetery board held a special meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the basement of the town hall at 49 Mill St. ext., Island Pond, Vt.

Butch opened the meeting at 5:55 p.m.

Present were commissioner's Butch Barney (chair), Ray Fontaine, Bobby Daniels.

The board discussed the need of increasing their stipend from \$100 a year to \$300 a year. The reason for the increase is that there is much work to be done in the cemetery and the amount of time being spent doing it. This will go into effect immediately.

Gates were discussed by the board. Ropes have been used in the past to close the cemetery to vehicles due to damage to the roads, but the ropes were cut last year and the road had to be repaired. There was an extensive discussion on purchasing gates and the cost thereof. It was finally decided by the board to build their own gates from pressure treated lumber, setting in 6x6 treated posts in cement, and painting them. Work will begin by the middle of June.

A motion was made, seconded, and all in favor for the gates and stipend.
