There are many things the board wants to accomplish in the cemetery, such as seeding different areas, building gates, cutting brush and trees hiding monuments, fixing headstones fallen over, etc. Priorities this year will be seeding and starting on gates.

Ray will check with Keith Gray on having hinges welded to the gate posts to support gates and the price to do the job.

There was a discussion on when the board could get together each week to accomplish work needed to be done. Several hours Friday afternoon will work best.
