**WATER & SEWER MINUTES**  
**Special Meeting**

The Brighton Water & Sewer board held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. In the basement of the town hall at 49 Mill St. Ext., Island Pond, Vt. On June 9, 2015.

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Butch opened the meeting at 6:00.

Lucy made a motion to accept minutes as read and Butch seconded the motion. All in favor.

Butch drafted a letter to Sharon Henault concerning her delinquent water and sewer bill. Sharon agreed to make payments of \$150 a month plus keeping up with current bills until she has a zero balance. If unable to make payment, she will send a letter explaining why to be reviewed by the board.

The discussion over the Maples will be on hold until the ordinances are in place by the engineers. Until the rate structure is in place, the question of units will on hold.

Butch will send a letter to Bob Dexter concerning his request over water and sewer, stating the board's hands are tied until the completion of the ordinances by the the engineers Aldrich and Elliott are in place. The board will ask this be made a priority.

The board decided that insulating the water lines took precedent over the painting of the reservoirs. This project will start with dale St. as soon as possible.

The water at Nilson's at the fishing village was shutoff. Will not re-connect until paid in full. This is the policy of the board concerning shutoffs.

Bruce Rolfe made a bid of \$100 for the old sander. The board decided to put it up for secret bid at the town garage. Will contact Mark Castonguay on this matter.

In Marty's comments, he stated his preference for Gervais Construction. The board decided to bid out any construction to be done by other construction operators such as Maxwell, Fortin, JBL, etc.

Marty told the board he has been doing some work for the cemetery by doing some research. Asked if the board had a problem with that. The board had no objections.

In the Commissioner's comments, Ralph asked what was being done with Belisle. This has been going on for two years. He believes this matter should be resolved and the board agreed. Belisle will have to hire a contractor to do the work he needs done. The board has gone as far as they will on this matter.
