## **WATER & SEWER MINUTES**

**April 19, 2016**

**The Brighton Water and sewer board held their regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the basement of the town hall at 49 Mill St. ext., Island Pond, Vt.**

Present at the meeting were commissioner's: Butch Barney(chair), Ralph Wilkins, Lucy Stevens operations manager: Marty Frizzell secretary: Jocelyne Barney

Butch opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Minutes of March 15, 2016 were read. Ralph made a motion to accept minutes as read and Lucy seconded the motion. All in favor.

There was no update to the agenda

There was no public comment

Marty was asked for an update on the aeration at the treatment plant. He stated no progress has been made, it is still working okay, but will need to be addressed soon. Marty was also asked for an update on the electrical panel on Meadow St. He said nothing has been done as of yet.

Lucy made a motion that all delinquent water & sewer agreements must be zero balance by December 31<sup>st</sup>, or a new agreement must be made. Ralph seconded the motion. All in favor.

The water and sewer board will meet with the selectboard on their first meeting in May to discuss sewer rates. The water board will set the new water & sewer rates at their meeting on the third Tuesday of May.

Marty's Comments.....there was a power outage on April 1<sup>st</sup> which was not duly warned because of faulty batteries. The problem is being corrected.

Marty said they will be flushing hydrants on May 16<sup>th</sup>.

Ralph asked how the progression was being made on the ordinances. Marty replied we will be getting together with Joel to finalize it.

The summer project is to paint the reservoirs as soon as possible.

The board discussed shutoffs due to non-payment and sending a two week notice to those who may be in jeopardy of having their water shutoff.
