

CEMETERY MINUTES OF MARCHE 27, 2018

March 27, 2018

Present at meeting was Ray Fontaine and Butch Barney.

Butch called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Minutes of December 28, 2017 were reviewed. Ray made a motion to accept minutes as read and Butch seconded the motion.

Update to agenda:

Ray made a motion to accept Dana Jacob's bid to do the mowing and trimming of the Protestant cemetery. Dana's was the only bid that came in.

Ray said that Neil Perry will help to erect a fence next to Memory Lane where there is none at this time to keep bicycles, bikes, four-wheelers from entering the cemetery other than by the gates.

Butch said he will paint the gates this year. They will be painted black.

Ray checked on getting adjustable supports to hold up the gates. Ace carries adjustable supports on wheels for approximately \$25. We will need eight.

Butch asked Ray to contact Department of Labor for using high school boys and girls to do menial work such as painting, trimming brush, finding corner markers, etc. No power equipment will be used.

Ray and Butch discussed putting corner markers to identify sections in the cemetery. They will be 4x4 posts with painted caps. It will be identified as the blue section, the red section, etc. This will greatly help in locating lots and loved ones.

Commissioner's comments:

Ray suggested cutting more brush and trees and brush hogging to open more cemetery sites and also to keep the vegetation from choking out potential areas. Butch agreed that was a good idea. Butch and Ray will be doing this.
