

Planning Board Meeting Minutes

February 6, 2023

Annie called the meeting to order at 4:08 P.M.

Jay Miller gives a presentation and update on the Lakeside Park Plan. Discussion continues on the concept plan and how snowmobiles will fit through the park during the winter season. The board discussed various topics including the location of the new ice rink that has a multipurpose use throughout the year.

Jeanne Gervais brought up the concern of how the snowmobile path might intrude onto the sidewalk if the path is limited based on the current design plan. Mark Vaillancourt brought up a variety of points as it relates to the pavers in the front of the park where snowmobiles might go over-top.

The board agreed on moving the location of the potential ice rink closer to the lakefront allowing for more seating along Lakeside Park in the Spring, Summer, and Fall.

The board indicated that it would be in the best interest of the town to pursue the project with additional stakeholders in mind during the next meeting.

Jay Miller indicated that in order to stick to the timeline of breaking ground after July 4th it would be important to hold an additional meeting with the stakeholders.

Anne Budrewicz motioned for the board to hold a special meeting on 02/13/2023 at 1:00 P.M. followed by both Mark Vaillancourt and Jeanne Gervais voting in agreeance to hold a special meeting next week.

Joel Cope (Zoning Administrator) gave his report indicating that individuals who did not seek a permit to build or extend existing property had officially reached back out to him. Residents continue to respond to Joel's request and permit applications are in the process of being completed.
