

SELECTBOARD MINUTES

February 19, 2020

Michael Strait called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Public Comment: James O’Gorman shared a draft of a memoir that he would like to have engraved on a granite plaque honoring his grandfather Charles Maw’s life and his contributions to our Town. James will be in touch with the board with further information about the design and size of this plaque.

Efficiency Vermont: Paul Greenier and Michelle McCutcheon-Schour were present to represent Efficiency Vermont. Our Town has been targeted as one of the communities with the greatest needs for their services. Paul and Michelle will be present at various times throughout the year, engaging with Town’s people in an effort to educate them on what the program offers.
