## SELECT BOARD MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 17, 2021

Chairperson, Michael Strait called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Updates to agenda: None.

Public comment: None.

Road Department: Mark updated the board on the status of the new dump truck. All that is left is to have the body installed and it will be complete.

Mark also told the board that the sand shed is till half full and the outdoor sand shed is completely full; so, winter supply is looking really good.

Buildings and maintenance: Bruce informed the board that he has replaced the floor tiles in the bathroom at the railroad depot.
