

SELECT BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 2, 2022

Present: Michael Strait, Jeanne Gervais, Heather McElroy, Andy Martin, and Teresa DeBonville.  
Attending virtually; Joel Cope, Paul Chambers, and Bruce Webster.

Chairperson, Michael Strait called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM.

Update Agenda: Nothing.

Road Department: Andy has been working on getting quotes for engineers for the East Brighton Bridge project.

Animal Control Officer: Scott Buchman has resigned as animal control officer effective immediately. Heather McElroy will call Renee Falconer to see if she wants to cover Brighton. The town will need to get the cages back from Scott Buchman.

Town meeting 2022 planning: We have no moderator for town meeting. The town clerk will contact Dan Keenan to see if he would be interested in the position.

Pay orders: The board reviewed and signed the pay orders for the road department account and the general fund account.

Approve previous meeting minutes: The board reviewed the minutes of the January 19, 2022 meeting and also the minutes of the special select board meeting held on January 28, 2022. A motion to approve the minutes as printed was made by Jeanne Gervais. Heather McElroy seconds the motion, all in favor, so carried.

Other business: Heather McElroy asked the board if they would be interested in some cubicles and some filing cabinets. The board said they were interested.
