

WATER/SEWER MEETING MINUTES
DECEMBER 15, 2020

Present: Lisa Moore, Ralph Wilkins, Brittany Goulet, Marty Frizzell, and Teresa DeBonville.

Chairperson, Lisa Moore called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Updates: The board will hold a special meeting on January 12, 2020 to go over the final 2020 budget figures and the proposed 2021 figures.

Lisa Moore updated the board on the status of the VCAAP Grant. These funds have been extinguished. There were 11 people who qualified in Brighton. If any of them will receive any help, the funds will be disbursed directly to the town.

Public comment: None.

Review previous minutes: The board reviewed the minutes of the October 20, 2020 meeting. Ralph Wilkins motions to approve the minutes with revision. Brittany Goulet seconds the motion, all in favor, so carried.

Marty's comments: Marty informed the board that both trucks have been undercoated.

The pump station on Back Street was braised when a truck went off the road. The truck just brushed the electrical panel and broke the clamps and bent the lock. Marty does not think there is any significant damage; but is trying to find out who the driver of the truck was in case more damage was done than has been noticed at this time.

Marty informed the board that we were in violation of suspended solids at the wastewater treatment plant due to algae. This is on the decline at this time and Marty feels that we will be in compliance by the next testing.

Marty informed the board that there is no detection of PFOA'S. This should not need to be tested again for 3 years.

Marty informed the board that we may get help from KAS and the insurance company on the problem out behind the town hall. There will be a meeting scheduled for Wednesday, December 16 at 2:00 PM on this.

Other business: Ralph Wilkins asked if any mandates from the state to test waste water for covid-19 had come through yet. Marty told him not as of yet.

Ralph asked about the status of the Pleasant Street Pump Station. Marty has sent the plans to Richard Gervais and thinks that a springtime dig will be planned. This pump station has had no

use; as the people using it have gone south or have not been spending time at their second homes.
