

WATER AND SEWER MEETING MINUTES MARCH 16, 2021

Present: Lisa Moore, Brittany Goulet, Ralph Wilkins, Marty Frizzell, and Teresa DeBonville.

Lisa Moore called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Updates: Updates included pump stations, upcoming training, and upcoming meeting on 90% preliminary engineering report.

The Derby Street pump station was down last week; but Marty informed the board that both pumps were repaired and running.

There will be a training on the engineering report coming up. Marty will check on the exact date.

An upcoming meeting will be held on April 13, 2021 from 10:00 to 11:30 AM on the 90% preliminary engineering report.

60% Preliminary engineering report meeting: The board was informed that a meeting will be held on March 30, 2021 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM on the 60% preliminary engineering report.

Marty informed the board that he has been speaking with the engineers to get them all the information they need; and that we are now waiting on them and the state.

Marty will get information to John Reilly on how many residential and commercial sewer customers we have.

Other business: Ralph asked about freeze ups this winter. Marty informed the board that we really have not had problems this year.

The board will look over the lease for Paul Lefebvre and change it from 1 year to a 3 year lease.
